





Prerequisite: Either Grade 9 Art AVI101, or Grade 10 Art AVI201 or AVI 202




Grade 12 Visual Arts AVI4M1

The studio program enables students to explore a range of materials, processes, and techniques that can be applied in their own art production. Students will also make connections between various works of art in personal, contemporary, historical and cultural connections.

Prerequisite: Grade 11 Visual Art, AVI3M1

<u>Units of Study:</u> Students will have the opportunity to create their own individualized custom Projects/artwork using media and subject matter of their choice. Students will also create a Portfolio for Post-Secondary.
